Catalog USMAI is the University System of Maryland's library catalog. Use it to find books, videotapes, magazines and other materials owned any USM library, including Langsdale and the UB Law Library. 

Tips for basic searches:

- Use AND in your search to retrieve books that contain BOTH keywords. Example: typing "business and international" will find books that include both business and international.
- Use OR in your search to find books with either of two similar terms. Example: death penalty or capital punishment will find books that include either phrase, but not necessarily both.
- Skip initial articles a, an, the, or their foreign equivalents.
- You may use either lower- or upper-case letters.
- Use the * character to find matches that contain portions of words. For example, gun* will retrieve gun, guns, gunners, gunnery, gunning, etc.
