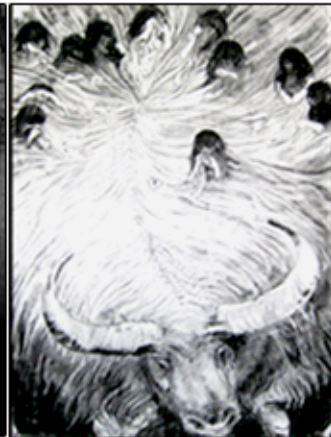
Maryland Institute College of Art students organize a traveling exhibition for charity
